## WHO?

This contest is open to all students in grades K-12 that attend public, private, or home school within the City of Wilmington. Only one entry may be submitted per student.

## HOW?

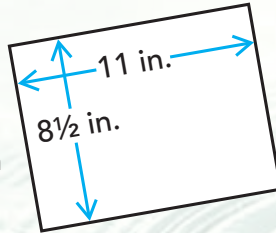
Create an ORIGINAL drawing that shows how we can keep Wilmington's waterways clean OR how you enjoy and value water.

## THE RULES:

Each entry MUST have a copy of the Official 2020 Art Contest Entry Form filled out legibly and entirely. TAPE OR GLUE THE FORM TO THE BACK OF YOUR DRAWING – NO STAPLES OR PAPER CLIPS PLEASE.

### Page Orientation and Type

Artwork must be HORIZONTAL and on an 8½ x 11 inch white sheet of paper with no lamination or protruding parts.



### No Trademarks

Please do not use any trademarked phrases, logos, or images (for example "Just Do It" or Coca Cola).

### Medium

Use any medium — crayons, makers, or paint. For street displays, color artwork is preferred but not required.

### Message

Artwork should show how to prevent pollution or how water is used or appreciated in our daily lives. Words must be limited to **no more than 5**. We encourage positive messages about clean water.

Three winning drawings are selected from four grade groups: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12.

First place drawings (one from each group) will be applied to the streets of Wilmington to act as a visual reminder that only rain should go down the storm drain. All winners, including a selection of honorable mentions, will be featured in a variety of art shows and displays throughout the City.

All twelve winners will receive a pizza party for their classroom and free busing to the Earth Day & Arbor Day Celebration along Market Street on Wednesday, April 22, 2020.

**A special ceremony with prizes will be held for students, teachers, and parents on a weekday evening in May.**

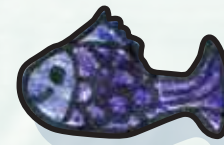
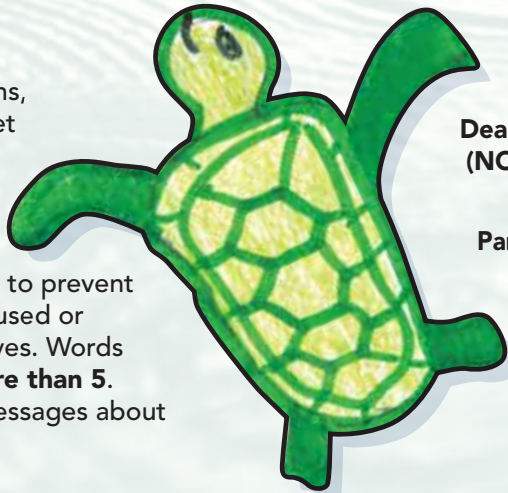
